REQUIREMENTS:

- All riders must wear helmets when mounted. Proper clothing is required for all classes.
- All horses on the grounds must have current negative coggins test and proof of vaccinations.
- Beginner and Novice Walk-Trot riders may not cross over into a canter class.
- Youth division must be under 18 years of age as of January 1st 2007. No refunds for classes entered unless injury to horse or rider has occurred.
- Classes may be combined if there are not enough entries.
- Judges decisions are final.
